
Art, tradition, nature and gastronomy in a globally unique geographical triangle.

The Museo de Belenes is in a huge 5000 m² building arranged over 7 exhibition rooms, a conference hall, cafeteria and souvenir shop.

NATIVITY SCENES BY NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL ARTISTS

With a tour of the Mollina Museo de Belenes, you can view over 60 artistic nativity scenes and around 1000 figures by renowned national and international aritsts. Nativity scenes in the Catalan, Italian or Andalusian schools... from monumental to miniature. Traditional nativity scenes versus avant-garde ones.

For more than a decade, the Fundación Díaz Caballero has been collecting nativity scenes from all over the world, and although Spain and Italy are most heavily represented, as countries with strong traditions of nativity art, it has a selection of pieces brough from countires such as India, the Czech Republic, Switzerland or Austria.



EXHIBITION OF THE ANDALUSIAN COUNTRYSIDE IN THE OUTSIDE AREA

The Museum has an outside area with a courtyard and gardens dedicated to an exhibition of the Andalusian countryside, with two oil mills, a collection of farming implements, and the recreation of a traditional Andalusian house with original objects.
