Location and History

LOCATION

The name Antequera comes from the Iberian world “Antikaria” which means “in front of the large limestone mass” alluding to the facing of the Peña de los Enamorados (Lovers' Rock) and El Torcal.

To the north of Málaga province, Antequera is right in the heart of Andalusia, nearly equidistant from the bordering main cities of Andalusia.



ANTEQUERA, SPLENDOUR OF THE RENAISSANCE

The apogee of Antequera started after the conquest of the town by the Christians. During the 16th century and afterwards, many convents, churches and places were built, such as the Royal Collegiate of Santa María La Mayor which, according to Professor Bonet Correa, it is the “first church with Renaissance sense built in Andalusia”.





THE BAROQUE STYLE IN ANTEQUERA THE CITY OF CHURCHES

As the poet, Gerardo Diego, described it, “the town of the white and Gongoristic churches” gathers 80% of the historical and artistic heritage of the Málaga province, with many Baroque works such as the churches of San Juan de Dios, Los Remedios and Belén, and the main altarpiece of the El Carmen church as the most significant example of this style.



Half-hidden in the network of streets, we discover the impressive palace-houses, constructions with beautiful facades and large courtyards surrounded by columns.

PALACE-HOUSES

THE ROMAN ANTEQUERA

Roma contributed to forming Antequera as a town. We keep the remains of former settlements such as Singilia Barba, Aratispi, the Villa de la Estación or the Termas de Santa María. However, our greatest exponent of Roman times is the most beautiful piece of bronze from the 1st century found in the Iberian Peninsula: El Efebo



MADINAT ANTAQIRA

The Arabian legacy left us Madinat Antaqira, a border town besieged by the constant battles between Muslims and Christians.

From this rich time, we keep the Alcazaba (citadel), a fortress enclosure dominated by two towers: the Homenaje one and the Torre Blanca (White Tower).

At the time, this complex was totally walled, and it had several access gates. We still can contemplate the Puerta de la Villa (Gate of the Ville) –currently, the Arco de Los Gigantes (Arch of the Giants)-, the Postigo de la Estrella (Wicket of the Star) and the Puerta de Málaga (Málaga Gate) which is now the Capilla de la Virgen de la Espera chapel.

DOLMENS SITE OF ANTEQUERA. WORLD HERITAGE

On the 15th of July 2016, UNESCO declared the Dolmens Site of Antequera a World Heritage. This was the recognition of the anthropologic and historical significance of a heritage complex made up of three prehistoric megalithic burial monuments (Menga, Viera and El Romeral) and two natural ones (El Torcal and the Peña de los Enamorados) being all of them connected to each other.

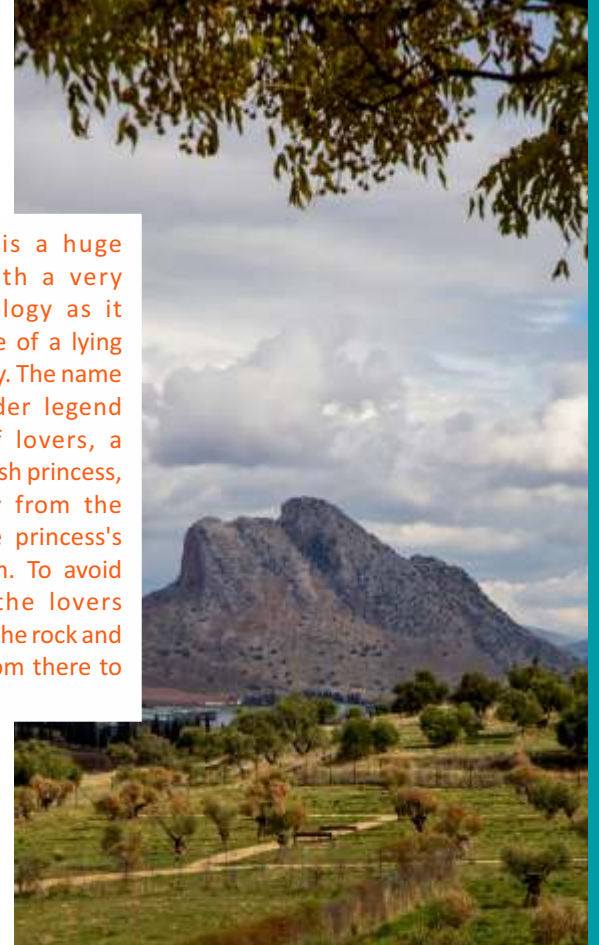

LA PEÑA de los ENAMORADOS

The Lover's Rock is a huge limestone rock with a very distinctive morphology as it resembles the profile of a lying man looking at the sky. The name comes from a border legend where a couple of lovers, a Christian and a Moorish princess, were running away from the soldiers sent by the princess's father to catch them. To avoid being separated, the lovers climbed to the top of the rock and threw themselves from there to be eternally together.





EL TORCAL DE ANTEQUERA

The El Torcal of Antequera is a 20 square kilometres karst landscape where water and wind have been moulding the rocks until forming large geological sculptures with amazing shapes, such as “El Tornillo” (screw), “El Sombrerillo” (the little hat), “El Adelantado” (the leaning one) and the “El Cáliz” (the chalice), among others. The whole complex is formed by limestone rocks originally placed on the seabed during the Jurassic Period, approximately 150 million years ago. The materials settled on the seabed surfaced due to the Alpine Folding during the Tertiary Period. Currently, it is the highest point in Málaga province.





Caminito del Rey

CAMINITO DEL REY

The King's Pathway is a passage built on the nearly vertical walls of the beautiful Desfiladero de los Gaitanes gorge. It is a pedestrian pathway attached to the rock, inside a spectacular canyon hanging over the river up to 105 meters in height.

Museums & Exhibitions Rooms



Museo de la Ciudad de Antequera - MVCA

The Museum of the Antequera Town (MVCA) is located inside the Palacio de Nájera, a manor house of the 18th century with an outstanding tower-viewpoint, cloister courtyard and a stairwell decorated with plasterworks. The Museum houses pieces of great value from the historical-artistic heritage of Antequera, such as the El Efebo (1st century), the San Francisco by Pedro de Mena, plus religious belongings from several parishes and fraternities, besides the rooms of the Antequera's artists, José M^a Fernández and Cristóbal Toral.

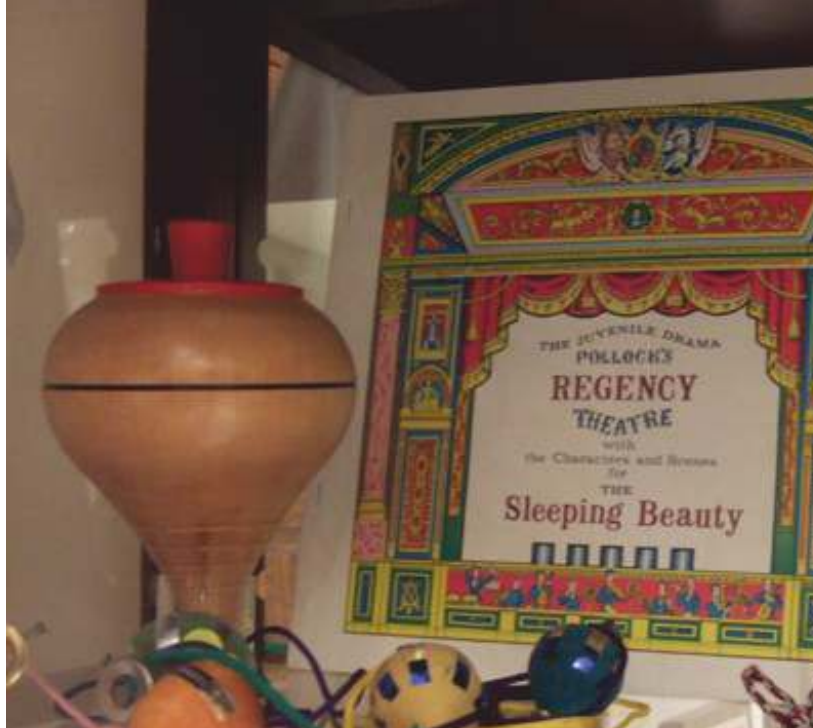

The Museum of the Cofradía del Socorro's fraternity is an old ambition of this Antequera's Holy Friday Brotherhood which has become true thanks to the brothers' effort and work. The rich processional heritage forged since the Fraternity's establishment in 1620 is reflected in a complete collection with outstanding jewelry and broderies dated between the end of the 15th century and the end of the 20th century.

Bull Fighting Art Permanent Exhibition (Temporary closed)

The permanent exhibition is placed in the Plaza de Toros of Antequera, one of the most beautiful bull rings of Andalusia. Although it was built in the 19th century, the bullfighting tradition in Antequera goes even back in time (17th century) and has prevailed during the years, being the collection of this exhibition one of its most notable displays. The Permanent Exhibition of Bull Fighting Art is on the high floor of the Plaza de Toros. The tour through the three exhibition rooms offers a general view of the bullfighting celebration in Spain, besides the local bullfighting history.

Museo Internacional de Arte Belenista

The largest Museum of Cribs in the world!

The 5,000 square meters of the International Museum of Nativity Scenes located in the Mollina village, just 15 minutes away from Antequera, houses over 70 extraordinary nativity scenes classified into dioramas, domes, and large cribs, plus nearly 2000 unique figures by acknowledged national and international sculptors, and which are arranged in seven exhibition rooms. In addition, there is a cafeteria, a souvenir shop, and an outdoor exhibition about the Andalusian countryside.

The Díaz Caballero Foundation is the promoter of this project which was born after a decade of work and of collecting figures from the whole world to provide a prominent space to exhibit and maintain the crib art.

Discover the art of the nativity scenes and cribs and let yourself be surprised by this cultural space placed in the heart of Andalusia. Open all the year.

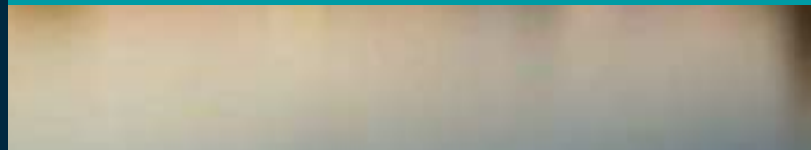

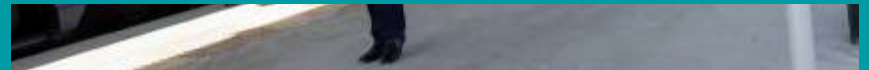
